

MARC TRAIN, AMTRAK & METRO SUBWAY ON METRORAIL SYSTEM

[Amtrak](#) passenger rail service, [MARC](#) trains and the [Metrorail system](#) all meet at [Union Station](#) in Washington, DC.

- Super Shuttle from Reagan National Airport (DCA) to Union Station, DC
[Super Shuttle](#) operates shared rides between Union Station and Reagan National Airport ([DCA](#)) @ \$14 per person each way (subject to change). Book [SuperShuttle Online](#) or call 1-800-258-3826. With shared rides and multiple stops, passengers could be on the bus 1 hour or longer each way.

Traveling between Union Station, Washington DC and Baltimore Convention Center:

- From Baltimore Convention Center, take the Light Rail to Camden Yards Station (or walk). From Camden Station take the [MARC](#) train to [Union Station](#), 50 Massachusetts Ave., NE, Washington, DC 20002, Phone: 202-289-1908. MARC train runs Monday - Friday ONLY. View MARC train [Schedule](#) between Camden Station and Washington Union Station. The trip takes just over 1 hour each way.

MARC is not the recommended method of transportation from Baltimore Washington Airport (BWI) to Baltimore Convention Center - Light Rail is recommended

- The MARC Train from BWI Rail Station is on the Penn Line. Baltimore Convention Center is on the Camden Line. The Penn Line and the Camden Line never meet. The Light Rail Line originating from BWI completely bypasses Penn Station. To get to the Baltimore Convention Center, take the Light Rail from BWI and get off at the Convention Center stop. AMTRAK

- Amtrak trains run 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Penn Station Baltimore (BAL) connects to a separate Light Rail Line which only runs from Penn Station to Camden Station and back. The 'Main' Light Rail Line from Baltimore Washington Airport runs from BWI to the Convention Center station as well as further stations servicing downtown hotels. These two completely separate Light Rail Lines do not meet.
- Baltimore Washington Airport (BWI) Amtrak station is approximately 11 miles south of Penn Station in downtown Baltimore, MD and 30 miles north of Union Station (WAS) in Washington, DC. Guests who fly into Reagan Washington National (DCA) can take the SuperShuttle to Union Station, then catch the Amtrak train to Baltimore Washington Airport (BWI) Amtrak station. From there, they can take the Light Rail to the Baltimore Convention Center Station and further stops servicing the downtown hotels. See Light Rail Public Transportation (pdf).
- Amtrak trains offer the following choices with rates based on time of day, frequency, speed, and class of seats. One-way rates range from \$14 - \$46. From Union Station (WAS) to Baltimore Washington Airport (BWI) Station passengers can travel on the Acela Express (faster trip, fewer stops, reserved seats), Northeast Regional (affordable service with multiple departures daily) or Vermonter (daily runs between Washington, DC & St. Albans, VT). Travel times between routes range from 21 to 29 minutes from WAS to BWI depending on the carrier and the time of day. See [Amtrak schedule](#) for specific details.

METRO SUBWAY
