Clipper Pass

These credit card-style passes work on all public transportation in San Francisco - BART (light rail), MUNI (busses & trolleys), CalTrain, and others. Highly convenient as you don't have to keep track of tickets or transfers - just pass the card over a reader when entering / exiting a station or bus. (If you're in San Francisco for a week, start with \$20-\$30 and add as needed.)

General SF Travel Advice

BART

Primarily for traveling north/south routes. Fewer stops and faster travel speed makes this the preferred choice if your destination is anywhere near where the line runs. Slightly more expensive than MUNI but well worth it in terms of convenience.

MUNI

Buses and trolleys travel throughout the city, but generally used for East-West travel. Far more available routes make trip planning a bit more difficult than with MUNI.

BayTripper

Real-time transit information, trip planning, scheduling information, access to BART/MUNI/Caltrain transit maps, taxi reservations, and bike/walking routes.

Traveling from Burlingame Hyatt to downtown San Francisco/Photonics West

A taxi just to SFO from the Hyatt runs \$15-20, so it is highly recommended to use this method:

- Take the free hotel shuttle to the airport and tell the driver your destination is the International Terminal. (This is the part of the airport closest to the BART transfer station.) (~10 min)
- Follow signs at the airport to the BART transfer station.
- Get on any northbound train (Pittsburg / Bay Point, Richmond, Dublin/Pleasanton, or Fremont.) Fare is ~\$9. (~30 min.)
- Exit at the Civic Center, Powell, or Montgomery station and walk to the Moscone Convention Center. (~5 min.)

Budget 45 min. - 1 hour for the trip.
